Reception - 72% at ARE (expected level)

Y1 Phonics - 85% ARE (our best ever!)

Y2 - Reading - 70%, Writing 70%, Maths 76%

Y6 - Reading - 79%, Writing 86%, Maths 86%, Grammar 83%
