Dear parents/ carers,

Once again thank you for your patience, co-operation and understanding with the ongoing issues relating to our water leak. I am very pleased to advise you that the source of the leak has now been identified and is in the process of being fixed. The contractors will work over the weekend and hope to have the issues resolved by Monday so that we fully operational once again.

The plan for Monday is for all children (Including Nursery and Reception) to return to school as normal. I am pleased to say that Breakfast club/ and all Afterschool clubs will be running as normal.

Unfortunately the kitchen will not be back up and running fully until Tuesday therefore all KS1 children and those children in KS2 who are entitled to free school meals will have a pack lunch provided for them. I am sorry we are not able to offer this service to non-free school meal children as the sandwiches are being made at another school, and they simply do not have the capacity to do so.

I would urge you to keep an eye on your emails and school website over the weekend where we will provide you with further updates on this situation.

If for any reason the leak cannot be fixed over the weekend school will still resume on Monday as normal. We have a company on standby that can provide us with portaloos with handwashing facilities. Therefore we will accept all children into school on Monday as normal.

Once again I would like to thank you for your support and patience. This situation was completely out of our hands and we hope that you feel that we have kept you informed, as soon as we have had any updates ourselves.

Have a lovely weekend all. We are looking forward to having all the children back with us on Monday.
