KS2 Sports Day at Hadley Stadium - Monday 24th June 2018

I am absolutely delighted to be writing to tell you about an amazing opportunity for our children in KS2. This year we have been invited to hold our KS2 sports day at Hadley Stadium, Bearwood. This exciting sports day is fast approaching and the children are looking forward to this fantastic event. Below are some details for the day.

Children will need to come to school on the day in their PE Kits. Please be reminded that this should be a plain white t-shirt, navy shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers would be most suitable for this type of sporting event. As always, for safety reasons no jewellery is allowed at all.

Coaches will be leaving school promptly at 9.00am and the children will be returning at approximately 12.30pm. The children will then have a picnic lunch in the playground once they have returned to school (weather permitting). **The children will require a packed lunch**, please ensure no fizzy drinks or glass bottles are brought into school. If your child is eligible for free school meals the kitchen will provide them a sandwich lunch automatically.

Children will need to bring plenty of water and healthy snacks for their morning; they will not require any money for the day. Please also ensure that they bring a sunhat/sun-cream as we are hoping for a lovely summer's day! You will also need to provide a waterproof should we continue to have this terrible rain we are currently experiencing.

We would love as many parent spectators as possible and you are very welcome to attend. Sadly, we are unable to provide any transport for parents. If you are interested in coming perhaps have a chat with other parent's in the playground and see if some of you can travel together. **We ask that you arrive at Hadley Stadium for 9.45am.** There will be an opening ceremony at 9.55am and the gates will close at 10am at the very latest.

The postcode for the stadium is B66 4NL. Access to the stadium is easiest at the front of the stadium on Waterloo Rd through the open green door and parking is available on the road. Alternatively, you can park in the car park at the back of the facility which is accessed from Sycamore Road and down Wilson Road.

Upon our return we will be holding a celebration assembly at 2.15pm of which parents are invited to. During this assembly the overall 1st, 2nd & 3rd place winners of all events will be awarded their medal. Technology permitting we are also hoping to show a slide show of photographs from the day. Please do come along and join us for this assembly.
