LUNCH-TIME AWARDS

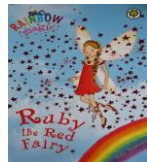


During lunch time the children are given a raffle ticket by a Lunch-time supervisor for good behaviour. This raffle is held every week and was won this week by:
